At the age of 15, Gerwyn Llewellyn Williams started work at St John's Colliery as a mining trainee. After serving an electrical apprenticeship at British Coal, he went on to become Coalface Electrician and Shift Engineer at Caerau Colliery. After two years British Coal Management Training, and various posts with British Coal, ending as Head of Field Services based at Nantgarw Colliery, Gerwyn took voluntary redundancy in 1987 and founded Ogwr Engineering Systems and Systems Logical (later sold to Ryan International). In 1995, he founded the UK Onshore Gas Group that has interests in approximately half a million acres of petroleum licences in the UK and holds joint ventures with Centrica and Eden Energy in Australia.
